The panelists alongside Dr. Obegi were H.E. Mr. Mansour Bteich, Minister of Economy & Trade, Mr. Jacques Sarraf, Chairman of MALIA Holding SAL & Chairman of the Global Lebanese Investors and Mr. Redwan Zaouk, COO of EMAAR Middle East.

Panelists shared valuable insights on available opportunities in the Levant region and focused on Lebanon as a hub for international reconstruction efforts, while highlighting boundless opportunities for the Lebanese Diaspora to partner with stakeholders for the reconstruction efforts.
